

DANCE – 1020

The 21 credit hour Dance Minor is designed for students with or without previous dance experience. The program focuses on studio techniques, theory, history and composition.

Dance Minor Program Requirements

- Dan 224 Dance Appreciation
- Dan 303 Dance Composition
- Plus One Lower Division Studio Technique
- Plus Two Upper Division Studio Technique
- Plus Two Upper Division Elective Courses

Students who enter the Dance Minor with appropriate prior dance training will not be required to accrue credits in lower division studio technique courses. Only 6 credits of lower division courses may be applied to the 21 credit hour dance minor. Upper division courses may be substituted with faculty permission if the student is ready for the next technical level.
