

HOSPITALITY ADMINISTRATION – 1437

The mission of the Hospitality and Tourism Department is to educate and develop enterprising students to become leaders in regional and global hospitality-tourism professions. The faculty is dedicated to frequent student interactions leading to effective learning and higher achievement. Courses available within the minor provide an opportunity for both general and specialized preparation for the field of hospitality in order to meet a variety of student interests and needs. The HA program at Buffalo State College is the largest accredited four year hospitality program in the SUNY system.

Guidelines for the HA minor: Students who have declared Hospitality Administration (#0437) as their major can not minor in this field. A 2.0 minimum cumulative grade point average is required for admission. A total of 19 designated credits must be completed. A maximum of two courses at the lower level division will be permitted. A maximum of two courses of transfer credit will be permitted. All course prerequisites are included in the minor program. Only matriculated students who intend to seek an undergraduate degree may be accepted into the minor program
