

## SCULPTURE – 1170

It is often desirable for students in areas such as Art Education and Design to pursue a concentrated but not all encompassing study of an art discipline outside of their major field. This widens the students' perspective, increases their professional and job-related opportunities and enhances qualifications for those planning to pursue a graduate degree, as well as satisfying other personal interests. Many students do this now but receive no formal recognition of their work. This Minor Program in Sculpture meets the needs of these students and recognizes their efforts and achievements.

### Required Courses

- FAR 101 Drawing I 3 credits
- FAR 240 Introductory Sculpture 3
- FAR 341 Intermediate Sculpture I
- FAR 342 Intermediate Sculpture II
- FAR 343 Advanced Sculpture

### Choice of one from 3 credit hours

- FAR 343 Advanced Sculpture (course repeatable up to 9 hours)
- FAR 345 Figure Modeling

### TOTAL REQUIREMENTS (18 credit hours)

ENTRY TO MINOR: Requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.

TRANSFER CREDIT: A maximum of 9 hours are accepted toward fulfillment of the minor.
