

PROCEDURES FOR PLACEMENT OF INCOMING FRESHMAN AND TRANSFER STUDENTS IN WRITING COURSES

- ✚ Students who score 440 or below on the writing section of their SAT exam or 16 or less on the ACT should register for ENG/CWP 099. Upon completion of the course, these students must register for, and successfully pass, ENG/CWP 101 and ENG/CWP 102.
- ✚ Students who score 440-600 on their SAT exam or 17-26 on the ACT must register for ENG/CWP 101. Upon completion of the course, these students must register for ENG/CWP 102.
- ✚ Those students who score 600 and above on their SAT exam, 27-31 on ACT, or have a score of 4 or 5 on the AP Language and Composition or the Literature and Composition exam will be exempt from taking ENG/CWP 101, but will be expected to register for ENG/CWP102.
- ✚ Exemption from the ENG/CWP requirement can only be achieved by the following means:
 1. an International Baccalaureate diploma or a score of 5 on the International Baccalaureate Group 1/Language A1 Higher Level exam
 2. a score of 700 or above on the writing section of the SAT.
- ✚ Any student who has not taken the SAT or the ACT exam will be asked to write a placement essay administered by the College Writing Program during orientation.
