- Intellectual Foundations courses
 - During the first two years of the program, students acquire a foundation in the arts, humanities, and social and natural sciences.
- Major requirements
 - The last two years are devoted to upper-division courses in management, marketing, human resources, law, finance, production and operations management, and a capstone course in business strategy.

- Management

 - Each concentration requires 5 courses (15 credit hours) in upper division concentration courses which must be completed at Buffalo State College.
 - Upper level business electives (6 cr hr) and BUS430 and BUS460 must be completed at Buffalo State College.

Degree Requirements

- Prior to acceptance into the program, students will be required to attain competency in mathematics (3 credit hours) and English composition (6 credit hours)
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

 - courses required but not yet completed
