Current

CHARGE FOR THE COMMITTEE ON ACADEMIC PLAN

It shall be the charge of the Academic Plan Committee to assume leadership in the intermediate and long-range planning of the overall academic function of the college. The Committee shall study the important matters affecting the academic development of the college and recommend changes and/or new proposals. The Committee shall seek the cooperation of faculty, students, administration, the non-teaching professional staff and off-campus consultants. Some of the more important areas of concern shall be:

- A. Mission of the College
- B. Master Plan
- C. Regionalism
- D. Enrollment Projections
- E. Review recommendations of accrediting agencies

Proposed

It shall be the charge of the Academic Plan Committee to assist in the intermediate and long-range planning of the overall academic functioning of the college. The Committee shall study the important matters affecting the academic development of the college and recommend changes and/or new proposals.
