AMCAS Fee Waiver Program & Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) Eligibility Requirements

- Download the Fee Assistance Program Application (FAP) from the website. Complete the FAP Application and submit federal income documentation and mail.

Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) Eligibility Requirements

- Fees are no longer waived, only discounted. Fee reduction form available in the financial aid office.
- Must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien
- Must be a college senior (89 credit hours) receiving federal financial aid through an undergraduate institution in the U.S., U.S. Territories, or Puerto Rico, or an unenrolled college graduate (who has applied for federal financial aid and has a Student Aid report (SAR) on file)
- Must be either a dependent college senior whose SAR shows a parental contribution of not more than \$1,200 or a self supporting senior whose SAR shows a contribution of not more than \$1,600 or an unenrolled college graduate whose SAR indicates self-supporting status and a contribution of not more than \$1,600. Valid during testing year July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

Law School Admission Test (LSAT) & Law School Data Assembly Service (LSDAS) Eligibility Requirements

- Financial aid offices of undergraduate institutions, non -LSAC- member law schools, prelaw advisors, or any other individual or organization cannot grant fee waivers.
- Obtain a fee waiver packet from Law School Admission Council (LSAC), a law school admission office, or a pre-law advisor.
- Complete the application and submit it along with your relevant federal income tax form(s) and completed LSAT/ LSDAS Registration Form.

The Praxis Series: Professional Assessments for Beginning Teachers (PPST) Eligibility Requirements

- Enrolled college undergraduate or graduate student receiving aid that meets the income guidelines, may be eligible for a fee waiver.
- You are ineligible if you have a master's, or doctoral degree.
- Complete the Fee Waiver Request Form (page 20) and registration form. If taking the Computerized – PPST, complete the CBT Fee Request form (page 21). The Financial Aid Director of your institution must complete the financial aid section on the form.
