## After School Instrumental Music Program

### Student Contract

The After School Instrumental Music Program is designed to provide students music lessons on an instrument of their choice in a safe, fun environment. Buffalo State College Music Department Faculty and pre-service music teachers provide lessons on a weekly basis free of charge. To ensure a quality experience for each participant, please read the following expectations.

1. Attendance: Weekly attendance is mandatory. If a student must miss a lesson due to illness, parents MUST notify the B.S.C. program coordinator BEFORE 3:00 p.m. on the scheduled lesson day. Campus West will NOT transfer absentee information to the program coordinator. Excessive absences (more than two) and failure to notify the coordinator may result in immediate dismissal from the program.

2. Behavior: Students are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner toward each other and their instructors. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and may result in immediate dismissal from the program.

3. Preparation: Students are expected to practice every day on assigned lesson material. Failure to practice and keep up with the class may result in dismissal from the program. Students are required to bring their instrument, method book, and practice notebook to every lesson.

4. Instrument Care: Students are expected to keep their instruments in working condition at all times. Repair arrangements may be made through your local music store or with the Campus West Instrumental Music Teacher. Repairs should be scheduled in a timely manner to ensure that students are practicing on the best possible instrument and to avoid a missed lesson due to a nonworking instrument. B.S.C. Music Faculty and students do no repair instruments.

5. Campus West Grades: Students are expected to maintain a minimum average of 75 in all subjects. Homework assignments must be complete and up to date. Failure to maintain grades may result in dismissal from the program.

6. Performances: Students are required to participate in the evening performance on April 27, 2007. More information will be provided at a later date.

7. Departure from Rockwell Hall: Students are to be picked up PROMPTLY at 4:00 p.m. from the bus loop on Rockwell Road. Students are not permitted to use public transportation and will not be escorted back to Campus West. No student will be allowed to leave campus without parental or guardian supervision. Excessive tardiness may result in dismissal from the program.
