### **What is DonorsChoose?**

DonorsChoose is a simple way to provide students with the books, technology, and supplies that they need to learn. At DonorsChoose.org, innovative and committed teachers like YOU propose ideas for needed resources, such as “Magical Math Centers” (\$200) or “Big Book Bonanza” (\$400) or “The Case of the Vanishing Pencils” (\$284). Individuals around the nation can search student projects by areas of interest, learn about classroom needs, and choose to fund the project idea(s) they find most compelling. Make sure YOUR idea is next!

### **How do I become a DonorsChoose teacher?**

1. **Register** at [www.donorschoose.org](http://www.donorschoose.org).
2. **Write** a brief project description (approximately 400 words) describing the proposed student project and how students will benefit. Tell your story and speak from the heart!
3. **Identify** the specific resources requested and their prices, and answer some brief questions.
4. **Watch** your idea be funded and come to life! And provide feedback for your donor(s).

It is a very simple, straightforward process.
