**COLUMN HEADINGS
AS THEY APPEAR ON THE ONLINE MASTER SCHEDULE**

- CRN (Course Reference Number):** Identifies a specific section of course.
- Catalog Number:** Identifies the department and course level.
- Course Title:** An abbreviated catalog title. Includes abbreviation for the requirement the course fulfills (see legend).
- Advisement Code:** Identifies what requirement this course will fulfill (see list below).
- Note or Prerequisite:** Special notes or requirements (may be coded), courses to have been completed prior to registering for this course. Reason for instructor permission coded here.
- Credit Hours:** Hours awarded for successful completion of the course.
- Meeting Time and Days:** Time of day and days of week course meets. Courses listed TBA or without a day/time assignment are to be arranged. Contact the department offering the course to obtain time and days.
- Building and Room:** Building and the room number of meeting place. Call department offering course without a building and/or room assignment or if course note designates as on-campus, off-campus, call department, or to be announced.
- Instructor:** Faculty member teaching the course.
- Open Quota:** Maximum number of students allowed to register for the course without meeting option.
- Reserve Quota:** Maximum number of students meeting the course option that may register for the course.
- Reserve Option:** Restriction on enrollment.
