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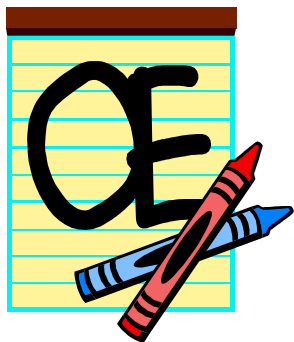

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# About the Program

Children who have difficulty making sounds and understanding language at a young age often have difficulty learning to read. Strong speech, language and auditory processing skills are critical to later reading and writing (literacy). Many children need direct instruction in order to develop these underlying skills. The program at Buffalo State College is designed to provide children with the phonological awareness, vocabulary, and written language skills needed for literacy and academic success.

Program goals include:

- Instruction to increase sound awareness and other basic auditory skills
- Vocabulary development
- Increasing ease of reading (fluency)
- Developing writing and spelling skills.

Children will be matched for age and skill level and placed in groups of 3-5. Graduate students in the Department of Speech-Language Pathology will provide services under the direct supervision of the Department's licensed and certified clinical faculty.

## Evaluations

An evaluation is required for entry into the program. Children will be selected for entry into the program on the basis of test results.

Evaluations will be conducted in June. Call 878-3530 to schedule your child's appointment.

## Sessions

Sessions will be held Monday through Thursday 9-11:30 AM from July 6 through July 30, 2009.

## Fees

There is a \$50 evaluation fee.

The cost for session enrollment is \$250. This covers all books and supplies. A limited number of scholarships will be available for those with demonstrated financial need.
